

YWST 13-18 Campout

JUNE 27, 28, 29

And the tradition carries on! We hope that all teens take part in this important bonding, team building, memorable camping trip! This is your trip!

Location

Camanche Reservoir – South Shore, Riverview Camp Ground, Camp Sites 27, 28, 30, 36 In the past there has been no phone reception.

Pre-Camp Preparation

This takes a village to put together and many areas for parents to help make it happen. Shopping, food prep, cooking, packing, donating supplies, driving, chaperones. Please step up and help where you can to make this happen.

Departure

We will leave immediately following the swim meet at YWST on the 27th. All hands on deck will be needed to pack U-Haul truck and get kids in carpool cars and off. They should plan on eating before leaving and or bringing lunch. Some cars will be stopping so bring cash if planning to buy something.

Arrival

All campers help unload and set up. No one takes off to lake till it's done. Dinner will be served approx. 7pm after set up and walk down to the lake. Campers will help with set up, cooking and clean up. Important to drink lots of water while on the trip.

Sleeping arrangements

- All swimmers sleep on tarps on ground in 2 separate areas. Chaperones will be sleeping in close vicinity. There will be separate boys and girls sleep area.
- Chaperones will sleep in tents and or other accommodations adjacent to swimmers and close vicinity.

Meal preparation & clean-up

- All teen campers are expected to help in meal preparation & clean up. Helping to keep camp area neat and orderly, helping out when needed or asked.

Boating

- If we have a boat safety will always be the number one priority. Only experienced adult drivers will be allowed to pilot the boats.

- Each boat takes out campers for approx. an hour of skiing, tubing, etc. then comes back to pick up the next load. A sign up will be taken and everyone will have an opportunity to go out. The driver is the absolute authority on the boat.

Chaperones

- There will be a minimum of 6 chaperones. They are volunteers.
- Chaperone Drivers will be assigned parking pass. Extra vehicles will be charged a \$12.00 fee per night.
- There will always be a chaperone at camp and with groups depending on activity.

General

- No one is to leave campground or camp area without being in a group and notifying chaperones.
- At all times campers should have a buddy who knows where they are at all times.
- Campers are not to go to restrooms or leave campsites by themselves.

Meals

- In general meal times will be 9am breakfast, Noon, lunch, and 7pm dinner. Snacks will be supplied throughout the day.
- All campers are required to help out whether cleaning, prepping food, cooking, getting water and or after meal clean up. Everyone will be asked to help. If everyone helps there's little work and lots of fun.
- Please notify us if there are food allergies or special diets needed.

Other Items of Note

- Illegal drugs or alcohol will result in immediate removal from trip and team.
- Disrespectful behavior toward a chaperone will be grounds for immediate removal from the trip. Parents will be called and teen will need to be picked up.
- Inappropriate conduct including but not limited to sexual contact will result in immediate removal from the trip.
- No visitors allowed.
- No swimming after dark.
- Campground policies must be adhered to by all campers.
- We represent Ygnacio Wood Swim Team at all times.

Registration and Fees

- Trip Fee \$100, covers campsites, transportation, food and misc. items
